Work Session: Finance Committee: 31aa Funding Conditions

Superintendent Nash gave the Board an overview of the recently amended State School Aid Act Section 31aa which allocates \$321 million to support school safety and student mental health initiatives across Michigan ("31aa Funding"). The amended Section 31aa imposes several conditions on districts that opt in to receive 31aa Funding.

In order to accept the funding, recipient districts must agree in advance to the following in the event of a "mass casualty event": (1) be subject to a comprehensive investigation following such a mass casualty event, (2) waive any privilege that would otherwise protect related information from disclosure, and (3) fully comply with the investigation process. The required waiver has no temporal limits, either retroactively or prospectively A Resolution will be put forth for adoption at the November 17, 2025 meeting. Board comments and questions were received and answered.

Policy Committee: Fall 2025 Policy Update

Superintendent Nash provided the Board with a review of the Vol. 40, No. 1 - Nondiscrimination update as well as the regular bi-annual policy updates which are up for first reading this evening. The policies in the Vol. 40, No. 1 - Nondiscrimination update were revised largely at client request to streamline the complex collection of Nondiscrimination, Anti-Harassment, and related issues, by consolidating several policies in order to provide a comprehensive approach to related employment issues. The update also included technical corrections to five (5) policies, correcting the address and contact information for the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights, formerly referencing the ClevelandOffice (now closed) to the Washington, D.C. office.

The regular Vol. 40, No. 1 - September 2025 policy updates had slight revisions based on recent legislation that was passed by the state as well as minor technical and grammar corrections. Board questions and comments followed.
