Count Days

This is where our funding comes from.

In October - Semester 1

In February - Semester 2

You must complete a "Count Day" Assignment for **every** online class on these dates by 11:59 pm to "count."

Count Days

Failure to do so means we will contact you and you will need to complete an assignment within 10 days.

If we do not complete an assignment with the 10 day window, your course will be dropped from your schedule and your community expert will be dropped. Parents will now be responsible for paying the CE.

We will not receive funding to compensate your community expert. So yes, it's that important!

Teacher of Record Contacts

Each week, the Teacher of Record will ask one question in each class. Please complete this after you have completed the assignment for the week. This is just a way for the mentor to check in with each student and is given extra credit points.

Our LMS (learning Management System) is Canvas.

- This allows for continuity across all classes so they will look and function the same, regardless of the instructor.
- Mastery Assignments, Related Assignment logs, and Two-Way Discussions will be on the student's To-Do-List.
- Notification system is superb.
- Most colleges use Canvas.

Each course generated by TRP is in Canvas.

- To access the class, students will use their trschools
 Gmail address for login and password given to them.
- Students are expected to complete one module/week.
- After due dates, students will have at least 2 weeks before the module closes and no credit will be given after that time.

- Students are expected to complete each course they are registered for.
- Except for extenuating circumstances, students will not be permitted to drop classes after count day.
- Failure to pass class with 60% or greater for credit, will result in a deduction of courses to the same number of courses receiving CR from the prior year. Ex. Student signed up for 3 courses but only receives CR (60%+) in 1 course. Student is now only eligible for 1 course the next year.

- All of our courses are virtual. We use Canvas for the courses we create.
 Each student registered with us receives a trschools email address.
- Someone will email you with login information before classes begin.
- Use your student trschools email address and password provided by registrar.
- Contact us immediately if you do not have the correct course(s) or correct number of courses.
- You will not be able to access classes until classes begin each semester.

- Through the LMS, students access courses and related documents, videos, and activities.
- There are 18 modules/assignments per semester.
- Students are required to complete their course(s) even if they stop attending the community expert.
- Credit (CR) for courses is awarded to students mastering 60% of the material.
- CR/NC does go on the student's record/transcript.

Canvas Overview for Students

Community Experts (CE)

- Many, but not all, of our classes do have community experts associated with them.
- Community expert experiences are optional experiences that relate to the online classes.
- Credit/no credit is determined by the grade in the online classes and <u>NOT</u> the community expert experience.
- The CE only gets compensated if the student completes the Count Day requirements.
- Before registering for courses, contact the community expert for availability and tell them you are with the TR Partnership.

Full Time Students

- We are part of TRCS, so full-time students are encouraged to take our 100% virtual classes.
- Students/Parents need to contact their school's secretary and/or scheduler to see that the course will work for their schedule and to determine if it is a good fit.
- If so, ask to have it put on the schedule.
- Contact the community expert for availability and tell them you are with the TR Partnership.

Technology Assistance

- Students must have access to a computer device and the internet to successfully complete these online courses.
- Pupils with more than 2 virtual courses have access to district provided devices and internet.
