	All TR Partnership courses are virtual, non-essential electives.	
	Community expert experiences are optional and not a part of required content for the online course.	
	Each TRP course receives Credit (CR) or No Credit (NC) that goes on the student's permanent school record.	
	CR is determined by a final grade of at least 60% in the online class and NOT from the community expert experience.	
	Funding for community experts is generated by completing count day requirements created by Michigan Department of Education.	
	There are two ways to complete MDE count day requirements and "count" for funding.	
	The 1st way to "count" is for the student to complete a "Count Day" assignment for every online class on count day by 11:59 pm. This is the easiest and preferred way.	
	The 2nd way to "count" is for the student to complete a two-way interaction with their mentor for 4 consecutive weeks during a Wednesday - Tuesday window (starting on count day). Even one missed two-way,	
	forfeits the "count" for the classes that don't have a completed 1st way on file. This is not as easy as completing the count day assignment on count day, so I will try my hardest to complete "count" with the 1st described above.	
	Count days for the 24/25 school year are:	
	October 2nd, first semester February 12th, second semester	



 Failure to "count" by completing either one of the two ways from above will result in my/my student's course and community expert being dropped from their schedule.	
 Failure to "count" means my/my student's community expert must now be paid by me, the parent/guardian.	
 It is the parent's responsibility to verify that the student has the correct courses and correct number of courses in Canvas to correlate with the community experts. If a course is not on your Canvas Dashboard (the place you will be able to view all of your courses in one place, just like	
Google Classroom from last year) We will not pay for the Community Expert. ie. One online class per community expert.	
 I/my student needs to complete the virtual course even if they drop their community expert experience.	
 Once I/my student is registered for classes, it is the parent's responsibility to contact the Community Expert (even the ones on Campus) and reserve my seat in the optional learning experience.	
 If I/my student chooses to change a community expert, I need to do it before classes begin, or I may have to forgo using a community expert extension of my learning for that particular online course.	
 I/my student needs to use an approved community expert listed on the CE sheet.	
 If my community expert is not listed, I will have them contact TRP to begin the onboarding process for community experts.	
 I understand that I need one online course for each community expert that I would like TRP to pay.	
I understand that a kit is considered a community expert and needs an online course to go with it. (Critical Thinking, Makerspace, Elements of Art,	
etc)	
 I understand that once an assignment is due, I (the student) has 2 weeks beyond the due date before the module is closed and a 0 is assigned.
