Re: Extended Learning Plan


Every month, the Board of Education, and the district leaders review our extended COVID-19 learning plan. On the March 15th Regular Board Meeting, the Board reviewed and approved a change to our TRCS Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan. The approved change contains a guideline to return grades 6-12 to 100% in-person instruction. The change does not affect our PreK-5th grade students or our students engaged in our Lincoln Learning program.

Each week the Branch-Hillsdale- St. Joseph Community Health Agency (BHSJCHA) issues a School Risk Assessment which includes the percentage of a 7 day average of positive COVID-19 tests in St. Joseph County. The Board approved Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan now states that when the BHSJCHA's School Risk Assessment reflects the 7 day average of positive COVID-19 tests in St. Joseph County to be 7.9% or less, grades 6-12 will return to 100% in person instruction within two days of the district receiving this metric. The District will begin monitoring for this metric beginning the week of March 15, 2021

The only two scenarios that would take us out of 100% in-person learning would be a mandate from the MDHHS to go to remote learning, or if a COVID positive case outbreak occurs that significantly impacts our students and staff. Each outbreak will be dealt with on an individual basis, in consultation with the BHSJCHA, TREA and the District in order to determine what course of action we will need to take to reduce the spread of the virus.


